INTRODUCTION

TEXT: "Be ye imitators of me, even as I also am of Christ." (v. 1).

- A. By Definition:
 - 1. "One who imitates. To produce a semblance of. To copy"
 - 2. In practice it is to use some one, or something as model. To pattern after.
 - 3. "Even as I also am of Christ." (II Thess. 3:7-9; Heb. 13:7, their faith).
- **B. LIMITATION:**
 - 1. We must be very careful to make sure we are imitating the right. 3Jn. 11.
 - 2. There are a lot of wrong examples; False teachers and Teachings.

OF PAUL

- A. As he begins this chapter. vs. 1,2.
 - 1. We are encouraged to follow him....as he follows Christ.
- B. II Thess. 3:7-9.
 - 1. He gave us his life as a pattern.
 - 2. He followed Christ....Therefore as we follow him....we follow Christ.

TRADITION - DOCTRINE

- A. v. 2. "Hold fast the tradition.."
 - 1. Bible filled with those who held to God's teaching. We should imitate.
 - 2. The blessings that resulted!
- B. THE OPPOSITE:
 - 1. Gal. 1:1-6: "I marvel that you are so quickly removed...another gospel.
 - 2. The Corinthians (Chapter 15).
- C. Any other example that you would like to use.

OF CHRIST - THE HEAD

- A. vs. 4-16; The usually discussion of this passage.
 - 1. Should a woman wear a hat or not...talking about a veil.
 - 2. Should a woman cut her hair...should a man let his grow too long? What is long....What is short?
 - 3. He was talking abut the natural distinction between man and woman.
- B. IF NOT CAREFUL WE OVERLOOK:
 - 1. Christ is our head........... 2. The head of Christ is God.
- C. THE LESSON:
 - 1. As Christ served, respected and obeyed God...His head...
 - 2. Let us imitate Him by Respecting....Serving and Obeying our Head....

In Not Making New Rules

- A. So easy for man to decide what man ...should or should not do.
 - 1. It then becomes "sin".
 - 2. As the Pharisees of old men bind heavy burdens on one another.
- B. v.16; Let's imitate the spirit and make sure we do not make NEW RULES.

IN WORSHIP

- A. Much said in this chapter about Lord's Supper.
 - 1. Understanding of the body and Blood of our Savior.
 - 2. We are to remember and respect the Death, Burial and Resurrection.
- B. There are THESE examples in worship we are to imitate.
 - 1. ATTITUDE:
 - a. They had a problem of bad attitude in worship.
 - b. Self centered, forgot the object of their worship.
 - 2. CONDUCT:
 - a. As a result their conduct...The way they behaved themselves was bad.
 - b. All sort of misconduct took place..eating..drinking..etc.
 - c. The waning in vs. 27 "worthy manner" What it means.
 - 3. CONTENT:
 - a. With bad attitude and improper conduct No wonder that the <u>content</u> (substance) of their worship became wrong!
 - b. When they came together it was for the worse, instead of the better.

C. ADMONITION:

- 1. Let a man prove himself. V. 28.
- 2. That your coming together be not unto judgment. v. 34.

CONCLUSION

- A. As a result of failing to imitate the good Paul; Correct Doctrine, Christ; it RESULTED IN:
 - 1. <u>Some are weak;</u> First step.....Slow change.
 - 2. Some are sick: Second step....or Phase.
 - 3. <u>Some were dead (sleep).</u> Final step.
- B. "Then the lust, when it hath conceived, beareth sin: and the sin, when it is full grown, bringeth forth death." (James 1:15).
- C. The Failure to **IMITATE** the right will results in: weak; sick; death.
- D. Let's prove (examine) ourselves and make sure we are **IMITATING:** Paul, The Doctrine; The Christ; and Worshiping in Spirit and Truth.
