INTRODUCTION

- A. Paul devotes I Cor. 15 to a discussion of the resurrection of Christ. In vs.12-19 seven "ifs" READ I Cor. 15:12-19.
- B. Big "if" in middle of <u>life</u>. Also in living of life.
- C. But the biggest "if" is raised by Paul. "But <u>if</u> there is no resurrection of dead....and <u>if</u> Christ be not risen..."if" in this life only we have hope.
- D. Think on it for a moment...There is no "if" on which so much depends.
- E. Problem of Corinthians...not so much a denial of Christ's resurrection but of man's...Paul argues that they must stand or fall together.
- F. CHAPTER IS DIVIDED IN FIVE PARTS.
 - 1. Christ is preached that he rose from dead. vs. 1-11.
 - 2. "If" there is no resurrection...then Christ was not raised. vs. 12-19.
 - 3. But Christ has been raised, and dead likewise will be raised. vs. 12-19.
 - 4. Just how will the dead be raised vs. 35-49.
 - 5. Through a resurrection, death is swallowed up in victory. vs. 50-58.

G. NOW LOOK AT EACH DIVISION SEPARATELY

CHRIST RAISED 1-11

- A. PAUL BEGINS BY CALLING ATTENTION TO GOSPEL; vs. 1-4.
 - 1. Our reception of it.
 - 2. Our regard for it.
 - 3. Our remission through it.
 - 4. Our reflection upon it.
 - 5. Our refuge in it.
- B. GOSPEL SOMETHING IN WHICH TO STAND...on which to stand.
 - 1. Gospel by which you are saved (Greek present tense)
 - 2. Unless ye believed in vain. *Faith is not to be vain but vital*.
- C. VERY BASIS OF GOSPEL IS Death, Burial, and Resurrection of Christ.
 - 1. Had there been no resurrection...been no gospel to preach.
 - 2. Their reasoning was that there was no bodily resurrection.....

Then Is Christ Not Risen 12-19

A. IF CHRIST NOT RAISED....FOUR THINGS:

- 1. Your faith is vain.
 - a. Man would lose all confidence in God.
 - b. Confidence in God's Word would be destroyed.

- 2. "Ye are yet in your sins....BECAUSE;
 - a. Christ raised for our justification, Romans 4:25.
 - b. If forgiveness goes, then peace goes...Freedom goes...Happiness goes; Heaven goes...ALL GOES.
- 3. THEN THEY ALSO WHICH ARE FALLEN ASLEEP IN Christ are perished.
- 4. Think what it would mean...Do away with John 14:2,3, II Tim. 4:8. Etc.
- B. "IF IN THIS LIFE ONLY WE HAVE HOPE IN CHRIST.....
- C. IN RESURRECTION WE HAVE HOPE...THIS BRINGS REJOICING.

But Christ Has Been Raised...

- A. READ v. 20.
- B. First fruits....more to come....Harvest.
- C. Jesus placed in tomb....Jews asked that Pilate make it sure. (Matt. 27:62-66) "Make sure as you can"
 - 1. Women asked who rolled away the stone.
 - 2. Why was the stone rolled away?

How Will The Dead Be Raised?

- A. PAUL CALLS TO MIND MYSTERY OF SEED.....Buried and raised.
 - 1. Different...yet the same.
 - 2. God assures us that He "shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body. (Phil 3:21).
 - 3. The body will be changed...but not our identity.
 - 4. Read vs. <u>43,44</u>.
 - 5. He tells us "flesh and blood cannot inherit Kingdom of Heaven.

B. II CORINTHIANS 5:1-10.

- 1. "For we know that if the earthly house of our tabernacle be dissolved,
- 2. "We have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal, in the heavens."

Death Swallowed Up In Victory

A. READ vs. 55-58.

- 1. The grave is not the end.
- 2. Does not mean all will be resurrected to live with God (John 5:29).
- 3. Death can be a great victory for those who through obedience to Christ are ready for it....**ARE YOU?**
- B. "Wherefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labor is not vain in the Lord," v. 58.
- v. 29.....Baptized to be a part of the resurrection! (But that is another lesson).
