INTRODUCTION

- A. Paul's earlier letter to the Corinthians.
- B. To evade the charges made by Paul They wanted to use another patter of judgment.
- C. Rather than being judged by Paul's word (God's Word) they chose to judge themselves by their own rules.
- D. Anyone who judges himself by his own rules will always pass!
- E. Paul writes this part of the letter (chapter ten) to remind them (and us) that it is God's judgment that counts.

...BY THEMSELVES

- A. v.12 "For we are not bold to number or compared ourselves with certain of them that commend themselves: but they themselves, measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves with themselves, are without understanding."
- B. Set themselves up as the standard.
 - 1. Decided what was and was not approved.
 - 2. Using themselves as the correct standard they had to pass.
- C. THEY IN THEIR WISDOM DETERMINED WHAT WAS right or wrong.
 - 1. What they wanted to do....was right.
 - 2. What they didn't like was wrong.
- D. Men fortify themselves against the gospel with their intellect and Will..
 - 1. They argue....reason from their pride. Can determine for self.
 - 2. Self-sufficiency....Self-righteous.
- E. It is **humbling** to accept the implications of the knowledge of God as revealed in the Gospel.
 - 1. God knows my need....Better than I
 - 2. Gospel....God has provided for me that which <u>I never could do.</u>

Compared With Others

- A. Always a great danger in comparing ourselves with others.
 - 1. Can always find someone worse than ourselves.
 - 2. How many people stay away from religion, because they know/or have heard of some proclaimed religious person who is worse than they.
- B. <u>God will not use comparative judgment.</u> Each will be judged according deeds done in this life....whether they be good or bad.
 - 1. You will have to give an account to God for your life.

 - 2. Every time we judge others by ourselves We Lose (They lose)
- B. Some in Corinth had passed judgment on Paul.
 - 1. Were wrong in every judgment.
 - 2. vs. 1 & 2. READ
 - 3. What he would do if he had to.
 - 4. Paul's Power was from God...vs. 4, 5

SELF APPROVED

- A. Many examples of those who were totally approved of By Themselves. We will look at two.
 - 1. **Haman:** Read Esther 6:6.
 - a. Tell the story of Haman, Mordcai and the Jews.
 - b. What led Haman to this final and fatal judgment of himself?
 - c. Who was rewarded..?
 - d. What finally happened to Haman.
 - 2. Church at Laodicea: (Rev. 3;16-18).
 - a. Their self judgment was: "I am rich, and have gotten riches, and have need of nothing."
 - b. God's Judgment: "Thou art the wretched one miserable and poor and blind and naked"
