

“PREACH ANOTHER JESUS”

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INTRODUCTION

II Cor. 11:1-6

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- A. One of the most consistent warnings of the New Testament is against false teaching and Teachers.
 - 1. Galatians 1.
 - 2. “Try the Spirits” “Prove all things” “Hold to that which is good” etc.
 - 3. II Peter 2: “But there arose false prophets also among the people, as among you also there shall be false teachers”...
 - B. Ezekiel is a great example from the Old Testament.
 - 1. Chapter 3, and 33.
 - 2. Duty of the watchman.
 - C. Thus it is not strange that Paul...to the Corinthians would warn about those who would “Preach Another Jesus”.
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“ANOTHER JESUS”

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- A. **What Is Meant By “Another Jesus”?**
 - 1. Not talking about someone other than the man of Galilee.
 - 2. Not talking of one different from the historical Jesus.
 - 3. Rather is talking about:
 - B. **Preaching Jesus as different from the one the apostles preached.**
 - 1. Gnostic
 - 2. Some would present Him as more....Some as less than the Son of God.
 - 3. Both wrong.
 - C. **Anything other than “Thou Art The Christ..The Son of God”** Matt. 16:18 Is to preach another Jesus.
 - D. **Ascribing to Him a Message He did not preach!**
- NOTICE; THE FOLLOWING TWO POINTS:
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A DIFFERENT SPIRIT

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- A. **What is the purpose....attitude Behind that which is being preached?**
 - B. **Not all “spirits” are from God. (I John 4:1). READ**
 - 1. False prophet and false spirit used interchangeable here.
 - 2. “Every spirit that confesses Jesus.....// that denies Jesus....
 - C. **We are challenged to “prove””examine” the spirit.**
 - 1. We must try, prove...the speaker.
 - 2. WE MUST TRY...MUST PROVE ...**THE MESSAGE!**
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“A DIFFERENT GOSPEL”

A. Galatians 1:6-10. READ

1. Explain “Pervert” the gospel.
2. All that is necessary for it to be “another Gospel” is to make changes, (even so called small ones) in it.

B. II Peter 2:1: “Destructive heresies”

1. To understand and appreciate the severity of this....READ the rest of the chapter.
2. Where it leads.

C. Romans 1:16: “The Gospel” is the power of God to save.

1. Those who pervert...God will Judge.
 - 2 How often the New Testament speaks of “Sound Doctrine” (Well, Healthy
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FALSE APOSTLES

A. “He That Cometh” v. 4. As opposed to having been sent from God.

1. Many false prophet shall arise..
2. Come of themselves.

B. **“Deceitful workers”**

1. Key word here is “Deceitful”
2. They deliberately look and sound good.

C. **Who Are False Apostles?**

1. Teach anything different (Galatians 1).
 2. They respond & conform to the wants of the people (II Tim. 4:3)
 3. Jeremiah VS. Hananiah.
 - a. What Jeremiah declared would be.
 - b. What Hananiah spoke....
 - c. **WHO WAS RIGHT?**
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Glory After The Flesh

- A. **THE JEWS**...As to who they were...historically.
1. Did this in John the Baptist ministry ...But God could raise up of these stones children to Abraham.
 2. In Jesus' Ministry. Any of example of self-righteousness of Pharisees, etc
 3. Same attitude being seen in the Corinthians.
 - a. Last weeks lesson...compare themselves with themselves.
 - b. Their commendation was after the flesh.
 - c. ***If this was legitimate..look what Paul could do...vs. 21-33.
- B. **MAN TODAY:**
1. How much of religion is a glorified show?
 2. Sad to say....Sad to see.
- C. **Bottom line of “glory after the flesh”:**
1. Is by own ideas and teaching save ourselves.
 2. Man decides that he knows more of what man needs than does God.
 3. Brings us back to “A Different Gospel”.
