INTRODUCTION

A. TEXT: "Ye are our epistle, written in our hearts, known and read of all men; being made manifest that ye are an epistle of Christ, ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in tables that are hearts of flesh." (II Cor. 3:2-3).

- A. WHAT IS AN EPISTLE?
 - 1. That which contains information and instruction.
 - 2. Differs from a letter in that respect.
 - 3. It is a means of communicating a message.
- B. HOW COULD PAUL SAY THEY WERE HIS EPISTLE?
 - 1. If you wanted to know what Paul taught Read his Epistle. (Corinthians)
 - 2. Much about Paul What he believed, did, etc. Could be seen in the church at Corinth.
 - 3. **They were what they were (Christians) because Paul had been there and taught them.
- C. HOW WERE THEY EPISTLES OF CHRIST?
 - 1. If you wanted to know about Christ....look at the Corinthian Christians.
 - 2. They reflected Christ.
 - 3. See more about this later in lesson.

Purpose Of An Epistle...

- A. TO CONVEY INFORMATION.
 - 1. For this purpose.
 - 2. To enlighten and inform the reader.
- B. TO BE READ.
 - 1. It is like a public speech and looks toward publication.
 - 2. Addressing all and sundry whom it may concern:

Epistle of New Covenant

- A. Old Was Ministration of Death...."written and engraved on stones"
 - 1. No doubt as to what he is referring to.
 - 2. The law that came through Moses. (v. 7).
- B. HOW, OR WHY WAS IT A MINISTRATION OF DEATH?
 - 1. Revealed the law of God.
 - 2. And man's inability to live a perfect life.
 - 3. And no final provision for forgiveness was made (without the shedding of blood...no forgiveness.) (Hebrews 9:22).
- C. YET IT CAME WITH GLORY!

- 1. So much so that children of Israel could not look on face of Moses.
- 2. The Old Ministration was great...And accomplished it purpose. (Gal. 3)

VEILED HEARTS

- A. V. 15 "unto this day, whensoever Moses is read, a veil lieth upon their hearts
 - 1. As Jesus said: "Their eyes they have closed"
 - 2. Did not want to understand with their hearts.
