- A. We Are Saved By the Grace of God.
  - 1. Eph. 2:8
  - 2. Rom. 5:2; Titus 2:11, etc.
- B. WHAT IS THE GRACE OF GOD?
  - 1. Unmerited Favor.
  - 2. It is all that God has done for us...The gift of Christ...The coming of a Savior. (Matt. 1:18-20..."God with us")
- C. "Now is the acceptable time; behold, now is the day of salvation" v.3.
  - 1. Way we sometimes use this verse, when we extend the invitation.
  - 2. That is true, but in context it has a larger meaning.
- D. How does Paul use it here?
  - 1. Compare....John 4:35...Jesus..."the fields are white already unto harvest".
  - 2. Both here in 2 Cor. 6, and John 4...The lesson is that GOD has made all preparation for the Salvation of man, and NOW, this AGE is the time and opportunity for man to be saved.
  - 3. THIS IS THE GRACE OF GOD!

### **Our Responsibility, Cont.**

### C. <u>NEGATIVE:</u>

- 1. "Giving no occasion of stumbling" A danger at Corinth. And today.
- 2. Some were living in such a way, as to turn people away from Christianity, and the Grace of God...Thus from Salvation.
- 3. There are people who will be glad of any excuse not to listen to the Gospel.
- 4. We need to follow Paul's example.

- A. MANY TRIALS THAT THE SERVANT OF GOD MUST ENDURE:
- B. Paul lists nine here, under 3 headings.
  - 1. <u>Afflictions :</u> From without
    - a. Pressure, mental and spiritual.
    - b. Hardships.

### 2. Hardships caused by others:

- a. Beatings
- b. Imprisonments
- c. Tumults, etc.

# 3. Hardships Paul accepted:

- a. Labor
- b. Fatigue
- c. Hunger
- d. Sleepless nights.

## C. Spiritual qualities which enable us to endure triumphantly.

- 1. Purity, Moral life.
- 2. Knowledge
- 3. Forbearance
- 4. Kindness love unfeigned.
- D. So much depends on our success:
  - 1. Our soul
  - 2. Their souls
  - 3. <u>ETERNITY</u>

### **THEREFORE**

- A. "Be not unequally yoked with unbelievers" v. 14
  - 1. Not addressing the subject of marriage.
  - 2. Though it could certainly be included.
  - 3. Yoked means ...to be joined together"
- B. NOTICE THE LIST OF CONTRASTS:
  - What <u>concord</u> has..... CHRIST with Belieal or idols
  - What fellowship has ..... RIGHTEOUSNESS with Iniquity
  - What communion has ..... LIGHT with Darkness
  - What portion has .....BELIEVERS with Unbelievers

What <u>agreement</u> has ......TEMPLE OF GOD with Idols.

- C. <u>A Christian Cannot Be Yoked To/or Joined in any activity that is wrong!</u>
- D. To be yoked to any of these would destroy the Christian, and brake being yoked with Christ (Matt. 11:28-30)
- E. The Corinthians were trying to hold onto **Both Sides**.
  - 1. "You cannot serve two maters" (Matt. 6:24)
  - 2. Contest on Mt. Carmel. (I Kings 18).

## AND GOD SAID.....

- A. Now is the acceptable time, behold, now is the day of Salvation"
  - 1. "Come ye out from among them, and be ye separate" v. 17-18
    - 2. "Touch no unclean thing"
- <u>B.</u> "I will be your God and ye shall be my people" "Ye shall be to me sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty"
