INTRODUCTION

TEXT: "But the multitude of the city was divided; and part held with the Jews, and part with the apostles." (Acts 14:4).

- A. From time to time we have all had to choose a side.
 - 1. Recently Democrat or Republican.
 - 2. Remember the school yard pitch up a bat, catch it and then hand over hand to see who gets first choice.
 - 3. Many choices in life are more difficult and far more important.
- B. IN THE TEXT the multitude of the city was divided. v. 4.
 - 1. A part held with the Jews.
 - 2. And part with the apostles.
 - 3. You can almost see a person being stopped and asked, "Which side are you on?"
 - 4. We can imagine the effort put forth to win a person to "our side".
- C. <u>How many times</u> has man been faced with this decision?
 - 1. Who is on the Lord's side?
 - 2. We must be on one side or the other. In this (service to God) we cannot Choose...not to Choose. WE MUST CHOOSE

BIBLICAL EXAMPLES

A. MT. CARMEL:

- 1. "How long go ye limping between the two sides? If Jehovah be God, follow Him; but if Baal, then follow him." I Kings 18:21
- 2. We know the story. The contest and the results.
- 3. But what choice did the people make? (Since Elijah had to flee, we assume most of them choose Baal.).

B. JOSHUA:

- 1. "Choose you this day whom ye will serve:".... but as for me and my house, we will serve Jehovah." (Joshua 24:14,15).
- 2. The people had entered and settled the Promised Land.
- 3. Now how were they going to live.....what would be their choice.
- 4. Later we read: "In those days there was no king in Israel: every man did that which was right in his own eyes." (Judges 17:6).
- 5. This was the choice they ultimately made and the Book of Judges is a testimony of what it cost them!

C. JESUS:

- 1. "Come unto me..." Matt. 11:28
- 2. "And he said unto all, If any man would come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me." (Luke 9:23).
- 3. Count the cost! Two parables....Luke 14:25-35.

- 4. "No man can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other; or else he will hold to one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon." Matt. 6:24.

Why We Choose - World

- 2. Of losing the chief seats. Matt. 23:6.
- 3. Of losing family. <u>Luke 12:49-53.</u>
- 4. Of losing life....
- B. PERSONAL: Gain or Loss.
 - 1. Rich Young Ruler...went away sorrowful...Why? "Had much possessions." Mark 10:22.
 - 2. "Howbeit what things were gain for me, these have I counted loss for Christ." Phil. 3:7.

C. PRIDE:

- 1. Saul.... the king.
- 2. Agrippa...was this his problem.

D. TEACHINGS:

- 1. "Many therefore of his disciples, when they heard this, said, This is a hard saying; who can hear it? Upon this many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him." (John 6:60, 66).
- 2. Prejudice.
- 3. Difficult or different
- 4. The Jews looking for an earthly kingdom.

Why We Choose - Jesus

A. LOVE:

- 1. Because God loved us...John 3:16.
- 2. What is the greatest commandment....Love God with all.
- 3. Love is a natural response to the love that God has given unto us.

- c. "Now I make known unto you, brethren, the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye received, wherein also ye stand, by which also ye are saved, if ye hold fast the word which I preached unto you, except ye believed in vain." (I Cor. 15:1-3).

- 3. Winner...more than Conqueror....

 - 3. Choose who you will serve.... "Which side are you going to be on?"
 - 4. Take up your cross....and follow Jesus.
