  - 2. "An imposter"
  - 3. The answer that is often given that falls just short of deity.

### I AM JESUS

- A. BOTH PHYSICAL AND SPIRITUAL IDENTITY.
  - 1. "Is not this the carpenter's son? Is not his mother called Mary (Matt. 13:55).
  - 2. "And she shall bring forth a son; and thou shalt call his name Jesus; for it is he that shall save his people from their sins." (Matt. 1:21).
- B. THE LIFE AND MINISTRY OF JESUS.
  - 1. From the little town of Bethlehem..
  - 2. His name is known throughout the world.

### **HEALER OF HURTS**

### A. "Jesus Christ healeth thee" (v. 34).

- 1. From the very beginning Jesus was the <u>Healer</u> of the physical hurts of the people.
- 2. Every kind of malady from leprosy to blindness was cured by Jesus.
- 3. The people marveled, and brought unto Him all who were sick.
- B. CASTING OUT DEMONS:
  - 1. A New Testament phenomenon
  - 2. Jesus had power over these.
- C. IMPORTANT NOTICE AND COMPARISON.
  - 1. How may times was sin compared to sickness/
  - 2. Disease such as leprosy.
- D. <u>Matthew 9:1-8...</u> Which is easier to say, Thy sins are forgiven or arise...walk.

- A. STORY IN ACTS 9:36ff.
  - 1. Dorcus a woman full of good works and almsdeeds.
  - 2. She fell sick and died. "V.37)
  - 3. Sent for Peter..He prayed and lifted her up.
- B. ILLUSTRATED IN A PHYSICAL WAY THAT JESUS IS THE GIVER OF LIFE.
  - 1. John 20:30,31... "that ye may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the son of god: and that believing ye may have <u>life</u> in his name.".
  - 2. John 14:1-4.... "the life"
- C. Answer to the Question THE GIVER OF LIFE!

#### CHANGER OF LIVES

- A. CHAPTER NINE BEGINS WITH <u>"SAUL, YET BREATHING</u> <u>THREATENING AND SLAUGHTER AGAINST THE DISCIPLES OF</u> <u>THE LORD."</u>
  - 1. Following the death of Stephen.
  - 2. He was <u>death</u> and <u>prison</u> to the disciples.
- B. THEN... "and straitway in the synagogues he proclaimed Jesus, that he is the son of God". v. 20.
  - 1. Immediately became God's prophet...Apostle for Christ.
  - 2. The Rest of New Testament reflects the life that he lived.
- C. QUESTION: <u>What changed Him?</u>
  - 1. Met Jesus.
  - 2. Changed his life forever.
