HE IS OUR PEACE

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INTRODUCTION Eph. 2:11-18

A. REMEMBER WHEN:

- 1. One morning in December 1941 you picked up the paper and the one word Headline was **WAR!**
- 2. For the next 4 years the thoughts of war filled our thinking.

B. REMEMBER WHEN:

- 1. One day the paper came with the one word Headline **PEACE!**
- 2. The thoughts that filled the mind when Peace was considered.
 - a. What it means.
 - b. What it Cost!!

PEACE

- A. I want to spend a little time with an abused passage of scripture from the Book of Isaiah chapter 11.
- B. READ Isaiah 11:1-6.
 - 1. Clear reference to the coming Christ.
 - 2. "The Spirit of Jehovah shall rest upon Him"
 - a. See (Matt.3:16; Mark 1:10; Luke 3;22; John 1:32).
 - b. The coming of the Holy Spirit upon Jesus.
 - 3. "with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth; and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked."
 - a. That is favor for that which is right.
 - b. Smite the earth...wicked.

C. THE PEACE OF HIS KINGDOM: (Read vs 6-9).

- 1. Figure drawn from the animal kingdom.
- 2. All these hereditary foes now dwell together in peaceful co-existence.
- 3. This is not some far off, yet to be, peace. Not something to be found in a literal reign of Jesus here upon the earth.
- 4. *This description of Peace and Harmony drawn from the animal kingdom can no more be taken literally than can the description of a rod proceeding out of the mouth of Jesus.
 - a. How completely they miss this message when they picture all of this taking place here on this literal earth.
 - b. They again emphasis the Physical over the Spiritual. Man's physical well being over the salvation of his soul.
- 5. This passage teaches that when the Messiah comes...He will bring peace for all those who are in Him.
- 6. What Kind Of Peace Does Jesus Bring To Us Today? Let Us Notice:

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WHAT KIND OF PEACE

- A. JESUS SAID: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give unto you; not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be fearful." (John 14:27).
 - 1. The "Peace" that Jesus gives was not going to follow the same line as the "peace" that the world seeks.
 - 2. It is not "this world" but "other world."
- B. Some how man still wishes for a "perfect world" a physical peace here and now.
 - 1. Why had man rather live here on this earth, even for extended time, when God has prepared a Heaven for him?
 - 2. Why is man "more comfortable" with the physical than with the spiritual?
- C. THE PEACE THAT JESUS DESCRIBED IN OUR TEXT: (Eph. 2:14)
 - 1. Peace between Jew and Gentile.
 - 2. Peace between men.
 - 3. Peace within our self.
 - 4. PEACE WITH GOD!!

CAUSE OF CONFLICT

A. GENESIS CHAPTER THREE:

- 1. Satan
- 2. Sin
- 3. "Therefore Jehovah God sent him forth from the garden of Eden, to till the ground from whence he was taken. So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden the Cherubim, and the flame of a sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life." v. 23-24.

B. WHAT SIN DOES:

- 1. Separate from God (Isaiah 59:1,2).
- 2. "The soul that sinneth, it shall die" (Ezek. 18:4).
- 3. "The wages of sin is death" (Rom. 6:23).
- 4. "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Rom. 3:23).
- 5. How desperately we need Peace!!

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PEACE WITH GOD

A. HOW DO WE OBTAIN PEACE WITH GOD?

- 1. "Being therefore justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." (Rom. 5:1).
- 2. "But now in Christ Jesus ye that once were far off are made nigh in the blood of Christ For he is our peace.... (Eph. 2:13,14).

B. HOW DID CHRIST MAKE PEACE?

- 1. "and through him to reconcile all things unto himself, having made peace through the blood of his cross; through him, I say, whether things upon the earth, or things in heavens." (Col. 1:20).
- 2. Left home in Heaven...came to earth, lived a perfect life, and died upon the cross, a sinless sacrifice for man.

C. WHAT IT COST:

- 1. It Cost God His Son. (John 3:16).
- 2. It Cost Christ His Life. "Have this mind in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: who, existing in the form of God, counted not the being on an equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being made in the likeness of men; and being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, becoming obedient even unto death, yea, the death of the cross." (Phil. 2;5-8).

D. HE IS OUR PEACE.....WHAT IT MEANS TO US.

- 1. "And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall guard your hearts and your thoughts in Christ Jesus." (Phil. 4:7).
- 2. Whatever happens in this world...The Christian has Peace with God... Peace that is Eternal.
- 3. Read again Isa. 11; Hear is Peace, not just now....But ETERNAL.
