 - 2. Abraham was blessed by Melchizedek.
 - 3. Levitical priest thus paid tithes to Melchizedek through Abraham.

C. BOTH KING AND PRIEST:

- 2. King of Righteousness...King of Salem (Peace.)
- 3. The combination of these two offices was to be a distinguishing characteristic of the Messiah.
- D. NO GENEALOGY:
