THE FAITH THAT SAVES

INTRODUCTION

- A. TEXT: "What doth it profit, my brethren, if a man say he hath faith, but have not works? Can that faith save him?" (v. 14).
 - 1. The way we usually use this passage.
 - a. As an argument against "Faith Only".
 - b. Make the argument. This is a good and true argument.
 - 2. We use this passage in showing the 'plan of salvation'.
- B. THE SETTING:
 - 1. James is writing to Christians.
 - 2. He is talking about 'everyday living.'
 - 3. He is talking about our 'bearing fruit' and God's people.
- C. WE WANT TO GIVE THE PASSAGE A CLOSER LOOK TODAY.
 - 1. So many say they have Faith.
 - a. James is saying "Prove It".
 - b. James is saying "Show Your Faith By The Way You Live!"
 - 2. He gives us a test.
 - 3. We need to "test" ourselves by what James says.

EXAMPLES OF FAITH

A. HIS FIRST EXAMPLE.....ABRAHAM!

- 1. The early life of Abraham.
 - a. God's promise.
 - b. Isaac is born. How does this show Abraham's faith?
- 2. LATER IN HIS LIFE.
 - a. God told Abraham to offer Isaac as a sacrifice.
 - b. Did Abraham have Faith?
- 3. We Know He Had Faith, By What He Did! (Gen. 22:9-12).
- B. HIS SECOND EXAMPLERAHAB!
 - 1. What she did.
 - a. She hid the spies from the king.
 - b. Let them down by a rope from Her window.
 - c. She risked her life because "For Jehovah your God, He is God in Heaven above and on earth beneath." (Joshua 2:11).
 - 2. Did she have faith? WE KNOW SHE DID Because of her actions.
 - a. Her works alone or faith alone did not save her....
 - b. Her deeds....motivated by her faith is what saved her!

HEBREWS 10:39

- A. "But we are not of them that shrink back unto perdition; but of them that have faith unto the saving of the soul." (Heb. 10:39).
 - 1. In this verse we read of the kind of faith that saves.
 - 2. Bible students know that the 11th chapter of <u>Hebrews</u> is a historical picture of the conduct of faith.
 - 3. We should remember that the last verse of chapter 10 introduces this as "faith unto the saving of the soul".
 - 4. WHAT DOES THIS KIND OF FAITH DO???
- B. IT SACRIFICES LIKE ABEL DID. (Heb. 11:4; Gen. 4:1-8).
 - 1. How did he sacrifice?
 - 2. How much?
 - 3. He did as God directed.
- C. IT WALKS WITH GOD LIKE ENOCH DID. (Heb. 11:5,6; Gen. 5:24).
 - 1. To "walk with" Demands agreement. (Amos 3:3).
 - 2. This Implies that...He Walked Where God Directed.
- D. IT HEEDS THE DIVINE WARNING LIKE NOAH DID: (11:7, Gen. 6-7).
 - 1. Noah believed that God could and would.
 - 2. Followed the pattern exactly.
 - 3. Christ is returning...<u>Are you in the Ark of Safety?</u>
- E. THIS KIND OF FAITH OBEY GOD LIKE ABRAHAM DID. (Gen. 12).
 - 1. Leave all....<u>Are we willing to leave the world?</u>
 - 2. Go Where.....Are we willing to go where God directs.
 - 3. Offer thy son.... How much do we love God?
- F. DELIBERATELY CHOOSES GOD'S WAY LIKE MOSES DID!
 - 1. Gave up the pleasure of sin. He made a <u>deliberate choice</u>, <u>knowing the cost.</u>
 - 2. We cannot follow God accidently.
 - 3. Christianity is a deliberate life.
 - 4. A saving faith causes us to choose God above every thing else.

CHRISTIANS TODAY

- A. REMEMBER...It was to Christians that James Addressed this Epistle.
 - 1. So many lay claim to Christianity.
 - 2. Become a little like the Jews of old.
 - 3. Made claims and an outward show.
- B. JAMES GIVES US A TEST TO PROVE OURSELVES!

THE TEST

- A. WHAT IS PURE RELIGION?? "Visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction,.." (James 1:27).
 - 1. The word "Visit".
 - 2. It means...."To take care of". To supply their needs.
 - 3. If you are not caring for them....you do not have the saving faith!
- B. "If a brother or sister be naked and in lack of daily food, and one of you say unto them, Go in peace, be ye warmed and filled; and yet ye give them not the things needful to the body; what doth it profit? Even so faith, if it have not works, is dead in itself." (James 2:15-17).
 - 1. Not enough to say, "be thou filled..."
 - 2. Or, I wish yo had something better...
- C. UNLESS WE DO SOMETHING ABOUT IT... OUR FAITH IS DEAD.... VAIN....FRUITLESS!

CONCLUSION

- A. HOW ABOUT US TODAY? ARE WE GUILTY OF HAVING A DEAD FAITH?
 - 1. We say NO!.
 - 2. Our faith is alive.
 - 3. Where are OUR WORKS?
 - 4. What are we doing besides saying "I am a Christian".
- B. "But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deluding your own selves." (James 1:22).
 - 1. May we all have the saving faith that Experiences God's Deliverance and Victories like the Israelites and these men and women of faith had!
 - 2. May we all be able to say: "...we are not of them that shrink back unto perdition; but of them that have faith unto the saving of the soul".
