INTRODUCTION

A. TEXT: "The Jews therefore came round about him, and said unto him, How long dost thou hold us in suspense? If thou art the Christ, <u>tell us plainly."</u> (John 10:24).

B. THE SETTING:

- 1. Jesus was in Jerusalem, near the end of His public ministry.
- 2. Many miracles had been performed, "the man born blind", etc.
- 3. Great teachings: The "I Am's" door, shepherd, etc.
- 4. <u>Much discussion:</u> questions and answers among the people.
 - 1. "Who is this?" Christ or...
 - 2. John the Baptist, Elijah, Jeremiah, or one of the prophets.
 - 3. While others said: "And many of them said, He hath a demon, and is mad; why hear ye him?" (v. 20). "Others said, These are not the sayings of one possessed with a demon. Can a demon open the eyes of the blind?" (v. 21).
- C. THUS THE QUESTION "TELL US PLAINLY".
 - 1. Plainly means: "Clearly, Openly; Simply."
 - 2. The Implication:
 - 1. If we are told, in so many words' we will believe.
 - 2. We will adjust our lives and actions, <u>all we need is to be told</u> "Clearly" or Simply."
- D. JESUS RESPONDED IN TWO WAYS:

MIRACLES

- A. Miracles: "works that I do in my Fathers name; these bear witness of me."
 - 1. How did Jesus begin His public ministry? (Water to wine, at Cana).
 - 2. Ye men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God unto you by mighty works and wonders and signs which God did by him in the midst of you, even as ye yourselves know;" (Acts 2:22).
 - 3. In answer to John the Baptist's question (Lk. 7:19).
 - 1. The question; "art thou he that cometh, or look we for another?"
 - 2. The answer: "go and tell John the things which ye have seen and heard; the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, the poor have good tidings preached to them." (Lk. 7:22).

B. DID THEY BELIEVE HIS MIRACLES:

- 1. Some did.
- 2. But others refused. (Luke 22:66-71).
- 3. Those in our text: vs 30-31. 'Took up stones again to stone him'.
- 4. His miracles could not be more plain...yet they believed not!

HIS TEACHINGS

A. FROM THE BEGINNING THEY WERE AMAZED.

- 1. As a 12 year old boy in the temple. (Lk. 2:41ff).
- 2. Great Multitudes (Matt. 5-7; John 6. Etc).
- 3. "And it came to pass, when Jesus had finished these words, the multitudes were astonished at his teachings; for he taught them as one having authority, and not as their scribes." (Matt. 7:28,29).

B. HE TAUGHT THEM PLAINLY.

- 1. From the Sermon on the Mount", the "But I say unto you" section.
- 2. Matt. 5:21-48.

C. WHAT DID THEY DO WHEN JESUS TOLD THEM PLAINLY?

- 1. In deeds and teachings.
- 2. "For this people's heart is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, And their eyes they have closed; Lest haply they should perceive with their eyes, And hear with their ears, And understand with their heart, And should turn again, And I should heal them." (Matt. 13:15).
- 3. See also Acts 28:27.

 - a. We are all going to the same place.
 - b. Just taking different routes.
- 2. Jesus Answered Plainly:
 - a. <u>John 14:6;</u> "I am the way...no one cometh unto the Father, but by me."
 - b. Acts 4:12; Quote...Is that clear, simple, plain?

C. WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

- 1. People say:
 - a. It doesn't matter as long as you are sincere.
 - b. Just say the "sinners prayer".
 - c. Put your hand on...take Jesus into your heart...
- 2. JESUS ANSWERED PLAINLY:
 - a. Acts 2:38; Repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus for the remission of sins."
 - b. <u>Heb. 5:9;</u> author, giver of eternal salvation to all them that obey Him.

D. IS BAPTISM REALLY ESSENTIAL?

- 1. People say:
 - a. That would be trying to earn salvation.
 - b. Water salvation.
 - c. I just don't see the point, the why, etc.
- 2. JESUS ANSWERED PLAINLY:
 - a. Acts 2:38.
 - b. Acts 10:48; "And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ."
 - c. <u>I Pet. 3:21;</u> "the like figure even baptism doth now save you".

E. DOES IT MAKE ANY DIFFERENCE HOW WE WORSHIP:

- 1. People say:
 - a. Do what makes you feel good.
 - b. Express yourself.
