MANY BELIEVED.....BUT—

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INTRODUCTION

- A. TEXT: "Nevertheless even of the rulers many believed on him; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess it, lest they should be put out of the synagogue: for they loved the glory that is of men more than the glory that is of God." (John 12:42,43)
- B. SETTING:
 - 1. Final week of the earthly ministry of Jesus.
 - 2. He had returned to Jerusalem.
 - 3. Multitudes turned out to greet Him.
 - 4. Some came to praise, others sought to <u>kill Him.</u> (Even planned to kill Lazarus, whom Jesus had raised from the dead, because of him many believed.
 - 5. But not all who **believed** were willing to obey! Same is true today!!

THOSE IN THE TEXT

A. MANY BELIEVED ON HIM!

- 1. They had both seen and heard Jesus.
- 2. No question of His greatness.
- 3. But the line had been drawn....If you followed Jesus, you had to leave the camp of the Pharisees.
- B. THOUGH MANY BELIEVED....They Did Not Confess It...WHY??
 - 1. Three reasons given.
 - 2. We want to examine them today.

BELIEVED....BUT...

- A. <u>FIRST</u> reason given was <u>**Religious Pressure.**</u>
 - 1. Because of the Pharisees.
 - 2. To the officers who returned, having failed to arrest Jesus. *"Hath any of the rulers believed on him, or of the Pharisees?"* (John 8:48).
 - 3. They listened to their religious teachers.
 - 4. This is what we have always done.
- B. <u>SECOND</u> reason given was <u>Security.</u>
 - 1. Afraid they would be put out of the synagogue.
 - 2. What the synagogue meant to them.
 - 3. What they would have lost.

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C. THIRD excuse given. Personal Pride!

- 1. Loved the glory that is of men.
- 2. Instead of being complemented they were afraid they would be ridiculed for following one from Galilee.
- 3. It would not have been the popular decision or thing to do.

OTHERS

A. THE YOUNG RULER. (Matt. 19:16-22).

- 1. Knew he had need. "Teacher what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life?"
- 2. Jesus' answer was for him to obey.
- 3. Up to this point he had.... "What lack I yet?"
- 4. "Jesus said unto him, If thou wouldest be perfect, go, sell that which thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow me. But when the young man heard the saying, he went away sorrowful; for he was one that had great possessions." (Matt. 19:21-22).
- 5. He Believed.....BUT-----
- B. AGRIPPA (Acts 26).
 - 1. Paul on trial before the king.
 - 2. King Agrippa, believest thou the prophets? I know that thou believest."
 - 3. Again we have one who believes....BUT—
 - 4. He will always be remember as one who ALMOST became a Christian.

TODAY

- A. THERE ARE MANY TODAY LIKE THE RULERS OF JESUS' DAY.
 - 1. They Believe.....BUT-----
 - 2. What are some of the reasons given today?
- B. FAMILY PRESSURE.
 - 1. Family is not religious.
 - 2. Or Family is religiously divided.
 - 3. Would have to "break" with the family.
 - 4. Or it would divide the family.
 - 5. "If I become a Christian, it will mean that I think my parents are/will be lost.

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C. BECAUSE OF IGNORANCE.

- 1. Believe, but don't have any idea what else they should do.
- 2. And many do not want to know.
- 3. They Believe, But don't study God's Word.
- 4. The times of ignorance therefore God overlooked; but now he commandeth men that they should all everywhere repent" (Acts 17:30).
- D. LOVE OF PLEASURE. (Like the Jews).
 - 1. They Believe...But are not willing to give up the way of the world.
 - 2. If would require to much of a change in their life style.
 - 3. They simple would rather live like they do, than to obey God.

E. THIS IS A HARD SAYING!

- 1. "Many therefore of his disciples, when they heard this, said, This is a hard saying; who can hear it? Upon this many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him." (John 6:60, 66).
- 2. It required more than they were willing to do.
- 3. Did not look to the true meaning of life or the complete meaning of His teachings.

CONCLUSION

- A. WHAT IS THE RESULTS OF BELIEVING BUT...NOT OBEYING?
 - 1. "Even so faith, if it have not works, is dead in itself." (James 2;17).
 - 2. "For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, even so faith apart from works is dead." (James 2:26).
- B. CAN THAT FAITH SAVE?
 - 1. What about the Rich Young Ruler?
 - 2. Agrippa.
- C. CONSIDER.....WHAT IF—
 - 1. One Believes,.....But does not confess.. "Everyone therefore who shall confess me before men, him will I also confess before my Father who is in heaven. But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father who is in heaven." (Matt. 10:32,33).
 - 2. One Believes.....But does not Repent. "I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all in like manner perish." (Luke 13:3).
 - 3. One Believe.....But is not baptized? "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that disbelieveth shall be condemned." (Mark 16:16).
 - 4. II Thess. 1:8- vengeance to them that obey not the gospel.
