INTRODUCTION

- A. TEXT: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same beareth much fruit: for apart fro me ye can do nothing." (John 15:1,5).
- B. SETTING:
 - 1. It is the night of the betrayal of Jesus.
 - 2. His final discourse with the apostles.
 - 3. A discourse filled with words of comfort and encouragement.
 - 4. The end of several "I Am" lessons.

"USE OF "I AM"

- A. GOD, IN HIS APPEARANCE TO MOSES.
 - 1. Moses' question...."Who Will I say sent me...what is your name?"
 - 2. God answered: "I AM THAT I AM" (Ex. 3:14).
- B. God should always be thought of in this way, (I Am). Never as Was or Is.
 - 1. Man is limited by time and the tenses of time.
 - 2. God is not (READ Psalms 90:2) "Before the mountains were brought forth, Or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, Even from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God."
- C. Jesus Christ is the Revelation of God unto man today...to see the Father, we must see Christ.
 - 1. In response to the question "Show us the Father...."
 - 2. "Have I been so long time with you; and dost thou not know me, Philip? He that hath seen me hath seen the Father" 9Jn. 14:9).
 - 3. Let us see Christ today.
- D. We want to note with emphasis and application some of the statements that that Jesus pre-fixed with the words "I AM".

THE BREAD OF LIFE

- A. With this statement, Jesus compared himself to the "manna of the Old Testament. (John 6:35).
 - 1. The manna sustained the physical life of the children of Israel.
 - 2. In came down from God. (God was the source of the life giving food).
- B. CHRIST IS NOW TODAY THE BREAD OF LIFE!
 - 1. Spiritual food for Spiritual Life.
 - 2. Sent from God.
 - 3. Without which we cannot live. He is the Source Of Life.

The Door And The Shepherd

- A. "I AM THE DOOR" (John 10:9).
 - 1. The means of entrance.
 - 2. Entrance into what?
 - 3. " by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved."
- B. NO OTHER DOOR OF SALVATION.
 - 1. "And in none other is there salvation: for neither is there any other name under heaven, that is given among men, wherein we must be saved." (Acts 4;12).
 - 2. He who would try to enter some other way (other than by Christ) is the same as a thief and a robber.
- C. THE GOOD SHEPHERD.
 - 1. Without a Shepherd the sheep would be lost and die.
 - 2. Picture so often used because of the helplessness of sheep without a Shepherd.
 - 3. Would not know the way.
- D. THE ROLE OF THE SHEPHERD.
 - 1. Protects. Guards from harm.
 - 2. Feeds. "Makes me to lie down in green pastures...."

RESURRECTION AND LIFE

- A. "I AM THE RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE" (John 11:25).
 - 1. At the time of the death of Lazarus.
 - 2. The sisters had said... "Lord, if you had been here...he would not have died.
- B. THE POWER OF JESUS GOES BEYOND DEATH!
 - 1. "Though he die, yet shall he live."
 - 2. Jesus is the power of life, the "I Am" of life, today.

LIGHT

A. "I AM THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD" (John 12:46).

- 1. The purpose of light.
 - a. It dispels darkness.
 - b. Shows the way safely.
 - c. Reveals sin!
- B. We were delivered out of "darkness" into "Light" (Col. 1:13).
 - 1. Jesus did not say "I will be light..."
 - 2. Or, "that I was, 2000 years ago"
 - 3. BUT.... "I AM" the light of the world.
 - 4. ARE YOU IN THE LIGHT?

AGAIN.....I AM...

- A. "You call be, Teacher, and, Lord; and ye say well; for so I Am." (Jn. 13:13)
 - 1. Do we acknowledge Him as our Lord and Master.
 - 2. "I AM", now...not was...then....or will be.
- B. THREE MORE IN ONE VERSE. (John 14:6).
 - 1. *I am the way*". The way that leads to the Father. v. 12.
 - 2. *I am the truth*". Only the truth can guide us to the Father.
 - 3. *I am the life*". The source of life.
 - 4. He brought to light, life and immortality.... (II Tim. 1:10).

OUR TEXT

- A. "I AM THE VINE AND YE ARE THE BRANCHES" (15:1,5).
 - 1. Vine supports and gives life to the branch.
 - 2. The branch <u>must</u> abide in the vine.
 - 3. The branch apart from the vine will die!
- B. Must bear fruit to remain in the vine. Life must give life.
