INTRODUCTION

A. TEXT: "These things have I spoken unto you, that ye should not be caused to stumble." v. 1.

B. SETTING:

- A. Jesus, to the apostles on the night of His betrayal.
- B. Knowing the dangers they would face, He is preparing them so they will not stumble or fall. vs. 2-4.
- C. THE NEW TESTAMENT OFTEN WARNS US ABOUT....
 - A. Stumbling.
 - B. Of encountering a stumbling block.
 - C. Of being a "stumbling block."
 - D. The word "offence" comes from same root word.

D. BY DEFINITION:

- A. Originally was the name of the part of the trap to which the bait was attached.
- B. That which entices or causes one to be snared or trapped, to stumble and fall.
- C. Another word "proskamma" an obstacle against which one may dash his foot, to stumble, usually translated "offence". Used in reference to our NOT being a "stumbling block" (offence) which trips or causes others to fall.
- 4. What are some of the **Reasons Why We Stumble Fall!**

DARKNESS

- A. DARKNESS CAUSES ONE to Stumble and Fall in Physical Life.
 - 1. We all recognize the danger of walking around in the dark.
 - 2. Have you ever run into a chair, table, door, etc. that was hid by darkness?
- B. SPIRITUAL DARKNESS lack of knowledge is as dangerous to our soul, as night is to our body.
 - 1. "We grope for the all like the blind; yea, we grope as they that have no eyes: we stumble at noonday as in the twilight; among them that are lusty we are as dead men." (Isa. 59:10).
 - 2. The results of disobedience. "And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways:" (Deut. 28:29).

C. HOW DO WE AVOID THIS DANGER? Spiritual Darkness.

- 1. Jesus..... "I am The Light Of The World"
- 2. "In him was life; and the life was the light of men. And the light shineth in the darkness; and the darkness apprehended it not....There was the true light, even the light which lighteth every man, coming into the world. (John 1:4.5, 9).
- 3. In I John 1:7, we avoid the Darkness, If we WALK in the Light.

FALSE TEACHING

A. FALSE TEACHING WILL CAUSE ONE TO STUMBLE AND FALL.

- 1. "Because thou hast there some that hold the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to cast a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols, and to commit fornication." (Rev. 2;14).
- 2. The story begins in Numbers 22.
 - a. Balak, of Moab, sent for Balaam, Ask him to curse this people (Israel).
 - b. He could not do this "I cannot go beyond the word of Jehovah my God
- 3. His false counsel (Num. 31:16) led to the death of thousands of Israelites.
- 4. Cost him his life (Num. 31:8).

B. FALSE TEACHERS TODAY.

- 1. "Woe unto you lawyers! For ye took away the key of knowledge; ye entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in ye hindered." (Luke 11:52).
- 2. All of II Peter 2. It also alludes to Balaam.
- 3. Because False Teachers cause one to fall we are warned... "Beloved, believe not every spirit, but prove the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets are gone out into the world." (I Jn. 4:1).
- 4. Paul's warning to Timothy of Sound Doctrine, Both Letters.

Things Of This World

A. GOLD AND SILVER.

- 1. "They shall cast their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be as an unclean thing;....because it hath been the stumbling block of their iniquity." (Ezek. 7:19).
- 2. Matt. 6:19,20, What and Where is Your Treasure?

B. IDOLS:

- 1. Ezek. 14:1-5. "Take his idols into his heart....the stumbling block"
- 2. An Idol is anything that has first place in our life.

C. PRIDE: Self love.

- 1. "And the proud one shall stumble and fall," (Jer. 50:32).
- 2. Pride goes before destruction and the fall. (Prov. 16:18)
- 3. "Let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall" (I Cor. 10;12)

CHRIST

- A. TO THE JEW, The Cross Of Christ was a Stumbling Block.
 - 1. "but we preach Christ crucified, unto Jews a stumbling block, and unto Gentiles foolishness;" (I Cor. 1:23).
 - 2. What they (Jews) had expected and looked for.
- B. CHRIST, BÉCAME A STONE OF STUMBLING.
 - 1. "Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by works. They stumbled at the stone of stumbling" (Rom. 9:32).
 - 2. When the teachings of Jesus (But I way unto you) was different from their teachings and thinking....they stumbled.
- C. THE TEACHING OF CHRIST IS A STUMBLING BLOCK FOR MANY TODAY.
 - 1. What must I do to be saved?...They stumble at the teachings of Christ. Preferring their own way, ways.
 - 2. How many different "ways" do men teach for salvation today?
- D. THE NECESSITY OF LIVING A CHRISTIAN LIFE.
 - 1. Morality of the Christian life.
 - 2. People want to livelike they want to live. Yet have the blessings from God.
 - 3. Yet Jesus said. Except ye believe that I am He, ye shall die in your sins.

CONCLUSION

A. HOW CAN WE AVOID STUMBLING AND FALLING?

- 1. "Walk in the light" (I John 1:7). Jesus is the light of the world.
- 2. "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, And light unto my path." (Psa. 119. 105).
- B. Wherefore, brethren, give the more diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never stumble" (II Pet. 1:10).
- C. IF WE FOLLOW PETER'S LESSON (Christian Graces, 5-7) WE WILL:
 - 1. Add to our faith. Accept the teachings of Jesus. Be His disciple.
 - 2. Avoid false Teaching, by **adding knowledge**, therefore walk safely.
 - 3. Recognize and avoid the things of this world that would make us fall. Add self control, virtue, steadfastness. Etc.
 - 4. MAY WE ALWAYS WALK IN THE LIGHT, AND AVOID THOSE THINGS THAT WOULD CAUSE US TO STUMBLE AND FALL!
