1. Sower went forth to sow.
2. The seed fell on different kinds of ground, with different results.
3. Something all farmers have seen.

C. JESUS' EXPLANATION: 9-15.

1. The seed is the word of God.
 2. Soil is the hearts of men.
 3. The results are the way men respond to God's Word.

STORM AT SEA

A. You now travel with Jesus by boat across the Sea of Galilee.

1. During the crossing Jesus rests and sleeps.
2. Storm develops
3. All seems lost, the boat is about to sink.
4. In fear we awake Jesus.

B. "WHO IS THIS?"

1. He rebuked the wind and the water.
 2. *"And they ceased, and there was calm"*.
 3. **How is your day so far? It is not over yet.**

B. THE DEMONS RECOGNIZE JESUS.

1. Are cast into the swine.
2. The swine run into the sea and drown.

C. THE PEOPLE COME OUT TO MEET JESUS.

1. Out of fear....they ask him to depart.
 2. **How about you?? Having spent this much time with Jesus...What do you want to do?**
 3. Our choice....Turn back....Or continue through the day.

WHO TOUCHED ME

- A. *"As He went the multitudes thronged Him."* v. 42.
1. Jesus paused, asked the question, "Who is it that touched me?"
 2. Those with Jesus do not understand - In such a crowd Jesus must have been touched almost continually.
 3. Jesus explained, power had gone forth from me. v. 47.
- B. The woman with the "issue of blood" had been healed.

JAIRUS'S DAUGHTER

- A. Jairus: *"A ruler of the synagogue"*.
1. His 12 year old daughter is dying.
 2. Jesus has been asked, and is going to her house.
- B. THE MESSAGE COMES: *"Thy daughter is dead"*.
1. "Trouble not the teacher" v. 49.
 2. What a day we have already had.
- C. JESUS' DAY IS NOT OVER YET.
1. *"Fear not, for she shall be made whole."* v. 50.
 2. *"They laughed him to scorn, knowing that she was dead."* v. 53.
 3. *"But he, taking her by the hand, called, saying, Maiden, arise. And her spirit returned, and she rose up immediately: and he commanded that something be given her to eat."* v. 54-55.
 4. "And her parents were amazed" v. 56. **feel?**
 5. And us? **As we come to the end of a day in the life of Jesus..How do we**
