ADOPTION

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INTRODUCTION vs 3-6

A. BY DEFINITION:

- 1. It indicated generally the legal process by which a man might bring into his family, and endow with the status and privileges of a son, one who was not by nature his son or his kindred."
- 2. A process somewhat familiar to all of us. It is also used spiritually.
- B. IT IS A NEW TESTAMENT TEACHING:
 - 1. Not much said in Old Testament.
 - 2. But in the New, many references made to our being adopted into the family of God.
 - 3. <u>Text:</u> It is the process that was foreordained. Not selected individuals.

In The New Testament

- 1. Follows the Jewish custom, which conferred the benefits of the family on the adoptee.
- 2. Occurs only in Paul, and is a relationship conferred by God's act of grace.
- 3. Its intention and result is a change of status, planned from eternity and mediated by Jesus Christ (Eph. 1:5).
- 4. The adopted son of God possess all family rights, including access to the Father (Rom. 8:15).
- 5. Shares with Christ in the divine inheritance (Rom. 8:17).
- 6. "And because ye are sons, God sent forth the Spirit of his son into our hearts, crying, Abba, Father. So that thou art no longer a bond-servant, but a son; and if a son then an heir through God." (Gal. 4:6,7).
- 7. The slave who becomes an adopted son.

RESPONSIBILITY OF

- A. WHAT ARE THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE ONE ADOPTING?
 - 1. <u>Love.</u> Must be the motive for adoption.
 - 2. Must be able to <u>care for</u> and supply the needs of the one adopted.
 - 3. Be able to give $\underline{\text{Security.}}$
 - 4. Provide an inheritance.
 - 5. Give <u>Name</u>.

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B. HOW DOES GOD MEET THESE RESPONSIBILITIES?

- 1. <u>Love:</u>
 - a. John 3:16.
 - b. Because God is Love. I John 4:8.
- 2. <u>Care For:</u>
 - a. Matt. 6. Physical.
 - b. John 14:1ff the spiritual and eternal needs.
- 3. <u>Security:</u>
 - a. No one can pluck one out of His hand.
 - b. II Tim. 1. He is able to guard that which I have committed....
 - c. The whole of the Book of Revelation.
- 4. Inheritance:
 - a. "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to his great mercy begat us again unto a living hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, unto an <u>inheritance</u> <u>incorruptible</u>, ane undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you," (I Pet. 1:4).
 - b. Heb. 9:15 Eternal inheritance.
- 5. <u>Name:</u>
 - a. Isa. 62:2. *"thou shalt be called by a new name which the mouth of Jehovah shall name.*
 - b. The disciples were called Christians first at Antioch.

RESPONSIBILITY OF

WHAT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ONE ADOPTED?

- 1. <u>Love.</u>
 - a. The one who takes us in.
 - b. The one who gave us so much.
- 2. <u>Appreciation.</u>
 - a. As one learns what has been done for them.
 - b. Show that appreciation in the life they live.
 - c. Honor....The name by which you are called.
- 3. Follow Obey.
 - a. Respect.
 - b. What about the disobedient?
- 4. Wear the Name of the one who Adopts.
- B. HOW DO WE AS CHRISTIANS MEET THIS RESPONSIBILITY?
 - 1. Love. What is the Great Commandment.
 - a. Love God with your all.
 - b. As an adopted child of God we must love Him.

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- 2. Appreciation.
 - a. Must appreciate what God has done for us.
 - b. How do we show that appreciation?
 - c. In and with our life.
- 3. <u>Obey.</u>
 - a. We have His Word.
 - b. Must obey from the heart.
 - c. If we do not obey we do not love.
- 4. <u>Name!</u>
 - a. If adopted we wear the name of one who adopts us.
 - b. What if we wanted to wear someone else name?
 - c. "And whatsoever ye do, in word or in deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him." (Col. 3;17)

How are We Adopted?

A. BY HIS WORD.

- 1. *"For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God."* Rom. 8:14.
- 2. "And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified with him." Rom. 8:17.
- B. BY HIS SON. "And because ye are sons, God sent forth the spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, Abba, Father So that thou art no longer a bondservant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir through God." (Gal. 4:6,7)
- C. HOW DO WE ENTER INTO GOD'S FAMILY?
 - 1. "For ye are all sons of God, through faith, in Christ Jesus, For as many of you as were baptized into Christ did put on Christ." (Gal. 3:26,27).
 - 2. Which brings us back to Ephesians 1. That tells us (v. 3) that <u>every</u> <u>spiritual blessing</u> is in Christ.
- D. FOREORDAINED:
 - 1. God foreordained the means and way by which man would/could be adopted.
 - 2. It is "through Jesus Christ" (1;5).
 - 3. Only those who are in Christ are adopted by God and share in His Inheritance!.
