

THE BEATITUDES IN THE BOOK OF REVELATION

HE THAT READS

“**Blessed** is he that reads, and they that hear the words of the prophecy, and keep the things that are written therein: for the time is at hand.” (1:3).

ARE THE DEAD

“And I heard a voice from heaven saying, Write, **Blessed** are the dead who die in the Lord from henceforth; yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labors; for their works follow with them.” (14:13).

HE THAT WATCHES

“Behold, I come as a thief. **Blessed** is he that watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.” (16:15).

THAT ARE BIDDEN

“And he saith unto me, Write, **Blessed** are they that are bidden to the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are true words of God.” (19:9)

The First Resurrection

“**Blessed** and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: over these the second death hath no power; but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.” (20:6; - Col. 1:11,12; - I Cor. 15:20 - 22; - Col. 3:1.)

KEEPS THE WORDS

“And behold, I come quickly. **Blessed** is he that keeps the words of the prophecy of this book.” (22:7).

That Wash Their Robes

“**Blessed** are they that wash their robes, that they may have the right to come to the tree of life, and may enter in by the gates into the city.” (22:14).
