WILL SIN REALLY CONDEMN

Good Outweighs Sin

- 1. Preacher: 'God will not really condemn anyone!
- 2. Just live a good, honest life. The sin will be forgotten.

DEFINITION

- 1. Sin is Lawlessness. (I John 3:4).
- 2. All unrighteousness is sin. (I John 5:17).
- 3. Knoweth to do good and doeth it not...is sin. (James 4;17).

Sin - Separates - Death

- 1. "But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you," (Isa. 59:2)
- 2. "For the wages os sin is death;" (Romans 6;23).
- 3. "Then the lust, when it hath conceived, beareth sin: and the sin, when it is fulgrown, bringeth forth death." (James 1;15).

OUR CHOICE

"Know ye not, that to whom ye present yourselves as servants unto obedience, his servants ye are whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?" (Rom. 6:16)

COVERING SINS

A. TWO WAYS:

- 1. The Wrong Way. (Proverbs 28:13) Try to cover it ourselves.
- 2. The Right Way. (Psa. 85:2) Let God cover our sins.

B. EXAMPLES OF WRONG WAY:

- 1. Adam & Eve hid behind the trees. (Gen. 3)
- 2. Adam blamed Eve; Eve blamed the Serpent.
- 3. Saul blamed the people. (I Sam. 15).
- 4. Aaron blamed the fire. (Ex. 32).
- 5. Ananias and Sapphira by lying (Acts 5).

C. RIGHT WAY:

- 1. Obey Gospel of Christ (Rom. 1;16; Acts 2;38)
- 2. Return to the Lord. (James 5:16)
- 3. Ask God's Forgivness (I John 1:9).
- 4. Receive Forgiveness (Psalms 85:2) "Thou hast covered all their sins."
