- A. Where the Galatians were when the Gospel arrived.
 - 1. Little back ground of people and country.
 - 2. Would have led to all kinds of idolatry.
 - 3. Resulted in bondage.
- B. BONDAGE OF: Idea of Slavery....Kinds of Bondage
 - 1. Ignorance
 - 2. Idolatry....The control of pagan deities.
 - 3. Sin....Satan
 - 4. DEATH

BONDAGE – **FREEDOM**

- A. BONDAGE: Often compared to the bondage of Israel to Egypt.
 - 1. Exodus 1:14.
 - 2. Exodus 13:3 "Ye came out of the house of bondage".
- B. FREEDOM: Follow the same comparison.
 - 1. It was easy to comprehend freedom when viewed this way.
 - 2. Rom. 8:21 "We have been delivered"
- C. ABSOLUTE DIFFERENCE:
 - 1. Point being made was the absolute difference between a bondsman and a freeman.
 - 2. Being a Slave or being Free

CHRIST GIVEN

- A. CHRIST GAVE US FREEDOM:
 - 1.
 - 2.
- B. FREEDOM FROM:
 - 1. Romans 6:18-22 READ
 - 2. Ignorance.
 - 3. Idolatry
 - 4. Death
- C. FREEDOM TO BE or TO DO
 - 1. Live for God.
 - 2. Live Righteous
 - 3. To become a child of God.
 - 4. Gal. 6:10; James 2 We are Free to do Real Good.

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COMPLETE FREEDOM

- A. CAN'T BE JUST A LITTLE FREE.....AND A LITTLE BONDAGE!
 - 1. Gal. 5:9
 - 2. History of the use of leaven in the New Testament.
- B. A Servant Cannot Belong To and Serve Two Masters.
 - 1. "His servant ye are whom ye obey" (Rom. 6:15-18).
 - 2. One can no more live a physical life, being both bond and free (the idea is contradictory) than he can live a life both in righteousness and sin at the same time.
- C. THE CHOICE OF JOSHUA.
 - 1. Must choose the one we will serve.
 - 2. Christ made possible for us to choose!

DANGER!!!

- A. From the several warnings given, it is obvious that the misuse and wrong idea about freedom became a problem for some.
 - 1. To equate spiritual freedom with physical freedom.
 - 2. Or spirit free...no concern with what the body did.
 - 3. Therefore many went into uncontrolled sin.
- B. <u>I Cor. 7:21:</u>
 - 1. Freedom in Christ does not necessarily change our situation in life.
 - 2. Bond-servant did not automatically become free.
 - 3. Look at case of Philemon and Onesimus.
- C. <u>I Peter 2:16.</u>
 - 1. Don't try to hide your actions behind a shield of claimed freedom.
 - 2. "God is only interested in my soul...He doesn't care what my body does."
 - 3. "I am in Christ and His blood covers...makes it impossible for God to see my sin.
- D. Galatians 5:13.
 - 1. Use it correctly...for profit of the soul.
 - 2. Serve others.
 - 3. "Thou shalt love thy neighbor as they self."

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HOW MADE FREE?

A. HOW DID CHRIST MAKE US FREE?

- 1. By taking our place. Romans 5:8.
- 2. By dying on the Cross (Eph. 2:12,13; John 3:16; Rom 5.)
- 3. By conquering death (I Cor. 15:50-58).
- 4. By paying the price....REDEEMED
 - a. In whom we have our redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, (Eph. 1:7).
 - b. *In whom we have our redemption the forgiveness of our sins* (Col. 1:14). (see also Gal. 3;12; Rom. 3:24)

B. WHEN - AT WHAT POINT DO WE BECOME FREE?

- 1. Must be born again (John 3:3-5).
- 2. "loosed us from our sins by his blood" (Rev. 1:7).
- 3. Acts 2;38for the remission of sins.
- 4. <u>In Christ.....a NEW creature</u> (II Cor. 5:17; Rom. 6:3,4).
 - a. Enter Christ (Gal. 3:26,27).
 - b. Romans 6:3.....baptized into Christ.

C. ARE YOU FREE??

- 1. Don't lose your freedom.
- 2. Can go back into world (II Peter 2:20-22).
