PHILADELPHIA

- 1. Was founded by Attalus the Second in about 150 B.C. Attalus was called Philadelphos...thus..."brotherly love".
- 2. While not an old city, it had become somewhat famous.
- 3. 'Both for its location and the wine that was made there.
- 4. It was built with the intention that it be a Missionary city. The Greek civilization was to be spread from this place to the wilds of Phrygia.
- 5. It was also known as "<u>The Burnt Land</u>" because it lay on the edge of a great volcanic area. Very fertile....Great vineyards.
- 6. But also very susceptible to Earth Quakes. (Destroyed in A.D. 17).
- 7. Many temples but the most prominent one was to the god of wine.
- 8. It was also custom to honor great men or great achievement by building a pillar on one of the temples and placing the man's name there. Some of these pillars still exist.
- 9. So Philadelphia was a prosperous, great city, with many Jews.

COMMENDATION

- A. No other church among the seven is more highly praised.
- B. "I HAVE SET BEFORE THEE AN OPEN DOOR".
 - 1. When we work other opportunities will present themselves.
 - 2. Remember that this was a Missionary city for Greek culture.
 - 3. The open door of opportunity for them is applied to the church.
 - 4. The healthiest church is the most active.
 - 5. Where is the door of opportunity.

- D. COMMENDED BECAUSE THEY STOOD TRUE AGAINST THE pressure of the Jews. (Who again were called "synagogue of Satan".) 1.When converted would find the synagogue door shut in their face.
 - 2. Find themselves excommunicated. Cursed as apostates.

COUNSEL

- A. "HOLD FAST THAT WHICH THOU HAST"
 - 1. The work they were doing.
 - 2. Their faithfulness to Christ and His Gospel.
- B. "THAT NO ONE TAKE THY CROWN"
 - 1. <u>II Timothy 4:8.</u>
 - 2. Let not one lead them astray...or in any manner cause them to fall.

PROMISE

- A. "I WILL MAKE HIM A PILLAR IN THE TEMPLE OF MY GOD."
 - 1. Mentioned a moment ago the custom of placing a man of honor name on pillar of the temples.
 - 2. May have been a reference to this.

B. "AND HE SHALL GO OUT THENCE NO MORE"

- 1. Again remember that Philadelphia was noted for Earth Quakes.
- 2. When a tremor began the people would flee from the city to escape from falling building. Then return.
- 3. Perhaps we can see in this a promise of safety...that they in Christ would not have to flee in terror.
- 4. IT WAS NOT PROTECTION FROM DEATH THAT THE RISEN CHRIST OFFERED: IT WAS DELIVERANCE FROM THE **FEAR** OF DEATH.

C. THIS IS A PROMISE MADE TO YOU TODAY.

- 1. That if you will hold fast....
- 2. Then you will not have to fear death!
