

Helpful Hints for Studying the Bible

Choose a setting that will be conducive to Bible study.

- Free from noise and distractions.

Choose a time when you will be alert.

- Set aside a time when you will be rushed or distracted.

Determine that you intend to study the Bible rather than to read or browse.

Pray before entering your period of Bible study.

- Ask God to help you learn from the study you are about to undertake.
- Ask God to help you learn things that will help you better serve Him and help others.

Study the Bible with thoughtfulness and meditation.

Makes notes and markings in your Bible.

- Notes and markings do not desecrate your Bible.
- Markings will facilitate locating important information in future studies.

Endeavor to memorize passages of Scripture.

- Memorize the Books of the Bible.
- Memorize meaningful passages.

Plan to study through the entire Bible.

Develop a modest library of good Bible study helps.
