 - "to lead, bring; lead away, drive off. . .conduct, accompany; lead out, produce; conduct with force, drag, hurry away; guide, incite, entice; convey one's self, go away; pass or spend as time, celebrate" [Harper, pp. 5, 6).
- Under the topical definition of "to move, impel, of forces and influences affecting the mind," Thayer refers to Rom. 8:14 and Gal. 5:18) [Thayer, p. 9].
