"PROVERBS"

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INTRODUCTION

- A. Experience is the best teacher.....But the tuition if high!
- B. Proverbs are a literary device to "arrest attention, awaken responsive thought, and remained fixed in the memory.
- C. AUTHOR:
 - 1. Solomon (I Kings 4:29-34).
 - 2. If others wrote some of them (Proverbs 30;1, & 31:1) Still Solomon is responsible for presenting them to us.

WE NEED KNOWLEDGE

- A. Why Is It Necessary to seek the knowledge given from the book of Proverbs?
- B. Because of <u>man's deficiencies</u>. Look at <u>5</u> given in the Book.
 - 1. <u>Give Subtlety to the Simple.</u>"
 - a. Some people are gullible. '
 - b. Will believe anything.
 - c. Or as we say....they will fall for anything.
 - 2. <u>Next Solomon talks about **young people.**</u>
 - a. Nothing wrong with being young as long as we will admit it.
 - b. A lot of things the young do not know.
 - c. Also true of <u>spiritually</u> young.
 - d. Proverbs teaches the importance of ;and helps us to Mature.
 - 3. <u>The Inadequacy of the Wise.</u>
 - a. Those who claim to be wise are deficient because of their inadequacies of knowledge.
 - b. Wise men realize they must learn.
 - c. Really wise people know how relative is their wisdom.
 - 4. Men of Understanding (1:5)
 - a. A true understanding is seen in behavior.
 - b. Do we understand or just think we are understanding?
 - 5. <u>"Fools despise wisdom and instruction" (7)</u>
 - a. Bible word "fool" is not a persons lack of mental knowledge or equipment.
 - b. Is talking about a person's chosen attitude and fixed outlook.
 - c. Example: "Fools make a mock of sin." Or "Fool says in his heart there is no god.
- C. WITH THESE FIVE KINDS OF NEEDS....
 - 1. Check ourselves ... see where we fit. 2. Proverbs will help us overcome

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Procurement of Knowledge

A. HOW DO WE GET OR PROCURE THIS KIND OF KNOWLEDGE?

- 1. "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge" (1:7).
- 2. "Fear" as used in this verse is **awe, respect & love** all rolled up in one.
- 3. We get this knowledge by respecting the teaching of God.
- B. SOME OF THE BROAD IDEAS COVERED IN PROVERBS.
 - 1. Practical problems of everyday life. '
 - 2. Deals with the artificial gulf between the sacred and the secular. '
 - 3. Solomon especially praises self-control. (16:30).
 - 4. Exalt's industry and hard work. (10:5; 19:24; 20;4).
 - 5. Points to the central significance of the family in the social structure.
 - 6. Great importance of the woman in the home is found everywhere in Proverbs.
 - 7. Thrust of the book is that wisdom is infinitely greater value than technical skills or in possessions.

C. WE NEED THE KNOWLEDGE THAT GOD GIVES BECAUSE:

- 1. Satan is trying every day to create problems in our society. His Plan.....
 - a. To deny God.....Did God really create man...or did man create God?
 - b. To destroy moral values.
 - c. To destroy the family and dignity of human personality.
 - d. To deify man by the concepts of humanism....man is supreme.
 - e. To deny the supernatural.
- D. THE BOOK OF PROVERBS IS WRITTEN THAT WE MIGHT.....
 - 1. Understand the temporal and <u>tragic</u> consequences of sin.
 - 2. To help us see in all avenues of life that God's way is the only way.
 - 3. The Book of Proverbs wants us to live an <u>excellent life of happiness</u> and *ultimately insure our eternal welfare*.

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GOD'S WORD WILL.....

A. GIVE INSTRUCTION (3:11)

- 1. Discipline:
 - a. 3:11; word is "the chastening of the Lord"
 - b. 23:13 word translated "correction"
- 2. The idea is that the instruction of God's word is the discipline we need to help us mature.

B. <u>GIVE UNDERSTANDING</u>.

- 1. THE ABILITY TO DISCRIMINATE BETWEEN THINGS.
- 2. WE ARE GOING TO HAVE TO Discern what is true....what is false...right...wrong. God's Word gives this understanding.

C. BRINGS **DISCERNMENT.**

- 1. Look again at Understanding.
- 2. Add.
- D. <u>BRING **DISCRETION**</u>. (1:4).
 - 1. We must learn who God is.. What God says...What God requires of us.
 - 2. ****Discipline, Discrimination, Discernment and Discretion** will lead us to the **Discovery** of the will of God.

Book Preserved Because ...

- A. While all wisdom and knowledge is important, the most important is the understanding of God and His will for man.
 - 1. Both wisdom and knowledge are emphasized in this book.
 - 2. In the New Testament, James tells us to pray for wisdom... wisdom that is from above.
 - 3. Paul tells us to study to show our self approved unto God.
- B. The theme of the book of Proverbs is, "It is better to have wisdom and understanding than all the riches of the world".
- C. In proverbs, the emphasis is on wisdom as a way of life, and the aim of the book is not the achievement of material success but the inculcation of a godly righteous and sober life.
