Internal - Expressions and style of writer Comparison with other works

There are nineteen definite points of comparison such as these, which shows to me beyond any reasonable doubt that John did write this book, whether epistle, as some claim, or treatise.

Another point which Dr. McKnight uses as proof is Demonstrative Prounoun "This"

In this book the writer does not identify himself either in the beginning or the ending and since an epistle is a letter and considered to be correspondence between one person and others, many do not consider this an epistle, but a treatise on the subject of the divinity and humanity of Jesus, combating false doctrine. THE EPISTLE

Prov. 8:22 The Lord possessed me in the beginning of his way, before his works of old. I was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was. When there were no depths, I was brought forth; when there were no fountains abounding with Before the mountains were settled, before the hills was I brought forth: while as yet he had not made the earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world. When he prepared the heavens, I was there: when he set a compass upon the face of the depth: when he established the clouds above: when he strengthened the fountains of the deep: When he gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass his commandment: when he appointed the foundations of the earth: Then I was by him, as one brought up with him: and I was daily his delight rejoicing always before him; Rejoicing in the habitable part of his earth; and my delights were with the sons of men.

Col. 1:17 And he is before all things and by him all things consist.

Seen with our eyes - Looked Upon

And great and important and weighty, we confess, is the hidden truth - the mystic secret - of godliness. He (God) was made visible in human flesh, justified and vindicated in the (Holy) Spitit, was seen by angels, preached among the nations (gentiles, KJV), believed on in the world (and) taken up in glory. ANT

1 Jno 3:5 And ye know that he was manifested to take away sins; and in him is no sin.

Mou know that He appeared in visible form and became Man to take away (upon Himself) sins, and in Him there is no sins - essentially and forever. ANT

Bear Witness

Luke 24:48 "Ye are witness of these things"... after giving great commission.

- Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. KjV

Doctrine of once saved - always saved

No one can have the truth of God in him, as has already been demmonstrated, and say we do not sin.....

A man will not say tacks don't hurt when he has tacks in his shoes.. we know that if he says tacks don't hurt, he does not have tacks in his shoes....

IF WE CONFESS OUR SINS - Psalm 32:5 Prove 28:13

homologeo "To confess, i.e., to admit or declare one's self guilty of what one is accused of..." "To say the same things as another i.e., to agree with, assent." Thayer's Greek-English Lexicon.
