## WORKBOOK ON SUCCESSFUL TEACHING T. Pierce Brown

#### INTRODUCTION

"Of making many books there is no end, and much study is a weariness of the flesh." Eccl. 12:12. The only justification we have for adding a workbook on successful teaching to the host of good books on the subject is that among all the good books, we were not able to find what we wanted in a workbook form.

This is what we wanted in a workbook: First, a Bible-centered workbook which, while using as reference materials any and all the works of man, would find both its inspiration and methods of successful teaching in the Book of books. Second, a workbook which would both encourage the student to find the principles of successful teaching in the Bible, and enable him to relate them to his own teaching experience in a practical way. Third, a workbook that could be used in a teacher-training course either by itself or as supplementary material with a more complete text as a background course of study.

In the bibliography at the end of this workbook we have listed some of the primary sources we have consulted in the preparation of this workbook.

You will note that the lessons in this workbook are divided into two parts. The first part deals with Bible principles and references related to the subject matter of the chapter. Part B deals with some specific questions related to information found in the texts listed in the bibliography. We particularly recommend such books as TEACH WITH SUCCESS, by Guy P. Leavitt, and HOW TO TEACH, by Thornton and Sharp.
