- -- trusting in one's own goodness
- -- expecting to earn salvation
- -- being proud of one's obedience
- seeking salvation throughJudaism/Mosaic Law

# LEGALISTIC/PHARISAICAL PRACTICES TODAY

- 1. "Anti" positions (one cup, no located preacher, non-cooperation, no Sunday school, no orphan homes)
- 2. Binding/restricting translations
- 3. Banning preaching locations
- Creating division between "personal indwelling" and "word only" views of the Holy Spirit
- 5. Specifying garment length
- 6. Constantly scrutinizing others for infractions
- 7. Listening to hearsay, thinking the worst, jumping to premature conclusions/judgments without sufficient evidence

# WHAT IS LIBERALISM?

#### Classic Sense:

Denial of the miraculous

- --virgin birth
  - --resurrection
- -- O.T. miracles
- --inspiration

## General Usage:

Loosing where God has bound Relaxing Scriptural restrictions Introducing unauthorized practices

# SIGNS OF LIBERALISM WITHIN CHURCHES OF CHRIST

- 1. "Felt needs" vs. "Book, chapter and verse" preaching
- 2. Solos, choirs, instrumental music
- 3. Handclapping
- 4. Lifting up hands
- 5. Female worship leaders
- 6. Non-Sunday Lord's Supper
- 7. Drama
- 8. Religious holidays
- 9. Dedicating babies
- 10. "Contemporary" worship services
- 11. Ecumenism (fellowship, grace, unity, baptism)
- 12. Authority of elders
- 13. Lax morality (divorce/remarr., lottery, modesty)
- Holy Spirit (Calvinism and Pentecostalism)

## WHAT IS SPIRITUALITY?

## Spirituality is <u>NOT</u>:

- --a feeling of excitement
- --emotional euphoria
- --a vague sense of contentment
- --stimulation of pleasurable sensations

## Spirituality <u>IS</u>:

- -- rational assessment of Scripture
- --compliance with Spirit's instructions
- --knowing and doing God's will

# THE ADULTEROUS WOMAN JOHN 8

- 1. Two or more witnesses (Deut. 17:6; 19:15)
- 2. Both man and woman (Lev. 20:10; Deut. 22:22)
- 3. Witnesses must be eligible (Deut. 17:7; Rom. 2:1; Gal. 6:1)

# THE GRAIN FIELD Matthew 12

- 1. Lawful to pick from neighbor (Deut. 23:25)
- 2. Lawful on the Sabbath (Ex. 12:16)
- 3. David <u>did</u> sin (1 Sam. 21:3-6; Lev. 24:5-9)

## argumentum ad hominem

- 4. Temple priests work on the Sabbath (Numb. 28:9-10)
- 5. As priests serve God in the temple, so the disciples were serving Jesus
- 6. The surface concern for obedience was insincere (Hos. 6:6)
- 7. Jesus authored the Sabbath!

# COMMONALITIES BETWEEN PHARISES AND LIBERALS

- 1. Elitist attitude of exclusivity
- 2. Propensity for extremism
- 3. Inaccurate assessment of Scripture
- 4. Going beyond what is written
- 5. Inadequate grasp of biblical love

<u>Pharisee</u> -- insensitive, uncaring, runs rough shod over people

<u>Liberal</u> -- emotional, "touchy-feely," purely physical displays of affection

#### 6. Root motivations

- --pride (Lk. 18:11-12)
- --popularity (Matt. 23:5-7)
- --permissiveness (Matt. 23:3-4)
- --possessions (Lk. 16:14; 20:47)
