- INTRO: Much false teaching has been done on the heart. In the text we read of those bent on idolatry. Their hearts cannot understand: their hearts are deceived. We must have a change of heart. Note Heb. 10:22; Acts. 8:37. The heart is the fountain of every thought and action.

 - A. It is not physical heart that is to be changed. Why?
 - B. Believers are all to be of one heart. Acts 4:32; 1 Cor. 1:10.
 - C. Circumcision of heart. Rom. 2:29; note Acts 2:45.
 - D. With the heart we think. Prov. 23:7; Luke 6:45.
 - E. We reason and believe with the heart. Mark 2:8; Rom. 10:10.
 - F. We love with the heart. Rom. 5:5; Matt. 22:37.
 - G. We understand with the heart. Matt. 13:15.
 - H. Heart desires. Rom. 10:1.
 - I. We purpose in the heart. 2 Cor. 9:7; Acts 11:23.
 - J. Use Word to change heart. John 17:20; 2 Tim. 3:16-17, 4:1-5.
 - K. Truth to change heart. John 17:17; 1 Pet. 1:22.
 - L. Doctrine to change heart. Rom. 6:17; 2 Tim. 4:2.
 - M. Gospel. Rom. 1:16; 1 Cor. 15:1-2.
 - N. Must be pure. 2 Tim. 1:3; 1 Tim. 5:22; James 1:27.
