**Baptizo**— is the Greek Word for Immersion; Immersion is Baptism.  
**Rantizo**— is the Greek Word for Sprinkling; Sprinkling is Rantism.  
**Cheo**— is the Greek Word for Pouring; Pouring is Cheism.

### Pouring

## **BIBLE TEACHING ABOUT BAPTISM**

INTRO: Much teaching has been done on the subject of baptism. It has been written about in creed books, yet little truth has been preached. The Bible is the book we should go to learn about baptism.

### **I. WHAT IS BAPTISM?**

Baptizo—is the Greek word for immersion; immersion is baptism.

Rantizo—is the Greek word for sprinkling; sprinkling is rantism.

Cheo—is the Greek word for pouring; pouring is cheism.

Sprinkling—is not found.
