- C. Sympathetic Eyes. John 11:33-35. "Oh Jerusalem, Jerusalem, (how often would I have). Matt. 23:37.
- D. Hopeful Eyes. Rom. 8:18-19; Phil. 3:20.
- E. Open Eyes. John 9:10; Luke 24:45; Acts 17:11. "Now then these were more noble than those in Thessalonica in that they received the word with all readiness of mind."
