 - I. BIRTH

All are born into the world in a safe condition, regardless of man's teaching. The Bible is plain.

Isa. 59:1-2. Some, on reaching accountability, obey the gospel. Some start down the broad way to destruction. They "sow to flesh" until death. Gal. 6:7-8; Gal. 5:16-21. They end up in hell. Rev. 20:11-15.
