 - 1. Pronoun "his" II Cor. 2:11; pronoun "he" James 4:7
 - 2. Not a symbol of evil, with evil existing only in the heart.
- B. Names: (Satan John 13:27; Acts 5:3)
 - 1. Adversary, Psm. 109:6; Belial, II Cor. 6:15.
 - 2. Beelzebub, or, prince of demons, Matt. 12:24.
 - 3. Abaddon (Hebrew), or Apollyon (Greek) destroyer, Rev. 9:11.
 - 4. The devil (Greek diabolos, Matt. 4:1).
 - 5. Serpent, Gen. 3:1,4; Rev. 12:9; tempter, Matt. 4:3.
 - 6. Prince of this world, John 12:31; 14:30.
 - 7. Father of lies, John 8:44; murderer, John 8:44.

II. TRAITS

- A. Powerful
 - 1. Power of (Col. 1:13, and ruler of darkness (Eph. 6:12).
 - 2. Power of air (unseen realm) Eph. 2:2.
 - 3. God of this world, II Cor. 4:4; power of death, Heb. 2:14.
 - 4. Full of power, signs, lying wonders, II Thess. 2:9.
- B. Aggressive
 - 1. As a roaring lion, I Peter 5:8; a sower of evil, Mt. 13:36-39.
 - 2. Words in children of disobedience, Eph. 2:2.
- C. Subtle (Gen. 3:1)
 - 1. Lays snares, II Tim. 2:26; practices wiles, Eph. 4:11.
 - 2. Employes devices, II Cor. 2:11; transforms himself, II Cor. 11:14.

III. GOALS AND AIMS

- A. Furtherance of his kingdom
 - 1. His kingdom does exist, Mt. 12:26; of this world, Mt. 4:8-9.
- B. Destruction of kingdom of Christ.
 - 1. Antagonistic to Christ, Acts 26:18.
 - 2. Words against the word, Matt. 13:19.
 - 3. Deceives until unbelief results, II Cor. 4:4.
 - 4. However, cannot be ultimately victorious, Mt. 16:18.

IV. ULTIMATE DEFEAT AND END

- A. His defeat is sure, Mt. 25:41; John 12:31; 16:11.
- B. Christ, the victor, is to be triumphant, Col. 2:15.
 - 1. Through his power over death, Heb. 2:14.
 - 2. He will at last exercise that power completely, I Cor. 15:25-26.
- . The devil and his works will be destroyed, I John 3:8.
- D. Final end: Rev. 20:10.

 - A. A created angelic being who sinned and was cast out of heaven. John 8:44; Luke 10:18; Jude 6; II Peter 2:4; Rev. 12:7-9.
