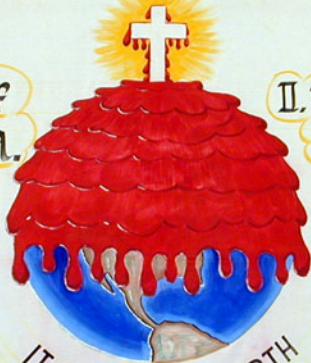

## **THE NEED OF JESUS BLOOD**

Eph. 1:3-7

INTRO: Did you ever stop to think of man's condition? God created man and placed him in the garden. He gave man dominion over all the earth. Gen. 1:26.

Man sinned against God. He left God and served Satan, thus turning his dominion over to him. Man's sins separated him from God. He was in a lost state.

Man was not able to do anything that could take away his sin. He did offer the blood of animals, but the blood of animals was not above the blood of man nor even on par with it. So the blood of animals could not take away sin. Something better than man was needed.

### **I. THE NEED OF JESUS' BLOOD. HEB. 9:11-14; HEB. 10:3-4.**

Under the Old Law, the High Priest had to enter once each year into the Holy of Holies and offer a sacrifice of blood of animals for himself and the rest of the congregation. But, blood of bulls and goats could not take away sin. A remembrance was made year-by-year. Animal blood and man's blood with all his sin could not take away sin. Jesus came and was tempted in all points like as we yet with our sin. Heb. 4:15. Jesus, then being better than man in that he had no sin, was able to make atonement for man's sin through His blood. The world was in darkness and without hope, but then came the light of the world. God so loved man that He sent His only Son to die for us.
