Acts 2

We have thousands who can testify to what we teach in Acts two, but we have nothing to prove the false teachings of men. Hence, thousands to nothing.

I. APOSTLES WERE BAPTIZED WITH THE HOLY GHOST.

John 16:13; Acts 1:5, 26; 2:1-4, 14.

II. MULTITUDE NOT PRESENT.

Acts 2:5-13. Multitude was not baptized with the Holy Spirit.

III. GOSPEL PREACHED.

Mark 16:15; Rom. 1:16; Acts 2:22-36.

IV. NOT BY DIRECT OPERATION

Acts 2:37-38, 40. No one was saved by a direct operation of the Holy Spirit.

V. FAITH CAME BY WORD.

Acts 2:37-41; Rom. 10:17.

VI. NO DIRECT GIFT—BY PRAYER

Rom. 10:13-14. Cannot get faith by praying for it.

VII. BELIEVED—ASKED WHAT TO DO.

Acts 2:36-37.

VIII. NOT SAVED BY FAITH ONLY.

Acts 2:38-40.

IX. REPENT AND BE BAPTIZED UNTO REMISSION OF SINS.

Acts 2:38; Mat. 26:28.

X. NO REMISSION OR SPIRIT OFFERED BEFORE BAPTISM.

Acts 2:38, 5:32.

XI. BELIEVING PENITENTS BAPTIZED.

Acts 2:36-41.

XII. NO INFANTS; NO ALTAR CALL

Acts 8:12.

XIII. 3000 BAPTIZED—250 PER PREACHER.

Acts 2:41. Could be done in an hour, but text says that day.

XIV. SPRINKLING NOT BAPTISM.

- Rom. 6:4; Eunuch. Acts 8:38-39.
- XV. LORD ADDED THEM TO CHURCH.
Acts 2:47.
- XVI. DID NOT JOIN CHURCH OF CHOICE. NO VOTING; NOT SAVED FIRST.
- XVII. WORSHIPPED AS IT IS WRITTEN.
Acts 2:42.
- XVIII. NO HUMAN DEVICES—ENTERTAINMENT.
John 4:24; Matt. 15:9.
- XIX. WERE ALL UNITED.
John 17:20-21; Acts 2:44.
- XX. NOT A UNION MEETING. DIFFERENCE IN UNITY AND UNION (TWO CATS).
