

## **UNDERSTANDEST THOU WHAT THOU READEST?**

John 3:36; Matt. 7:21; Acts 8:30

INTRO: We have heard preachers scream "Faith Only" so much that this false doctrine has become a sickening ring in the ears of those who love the truth. On radio and television and in meetings, etc., we continually hear this false teaching. Seldom do we hear the truth. We want to show what the Bible says to the false statements.

- I. KNEEL BY YOUR RADIO. ACTS 8:36-38.
- II. JUST BELIEVE AND BE SAVED. LUKE 13:3; ROM. 10:9-10; ACTS 2:38.
- III. BELIEVE, THAT'S ALL, JUST BELIEVE. HEB. 5:8-9.
- IV. YOU MUST GET SAVED. 1 PET. 3:21.

  Those who teach this doctrine say nothing can be done by us. Just get the Holy Spirit and He will save us. Yet, we still need to be saved.
- V. ONLY BELIEVE. 2 THESS. 1:7-9; ACTS 22:16.
- VI. HE WILL IN NO WISE REFUSE. MARK 16:15-16. Just believe and he will not refuse. False.
- VII. YOU CAN DO NOTHING. ACTS 2:40.
- VIII. GET SAVED AND THEN JOIN SOME CHURCH. ACTS 2:41, 47.

  We must be born again, and the Lord adds us to the church. You cannot join the Lord's church; you are born into the church. John 3:3-5.

CONCL: The Scriptures, in many places and in many ways, refute the erroneous doctrine of salvation by "Faith Only."
