WHAT WILL I DO WITH JESUS?

Matt. 27:22

INTRO: As one studies the Word, it is surprising to note how Jesus was treated then compared with how He is treated now. Jesus was brought before Pilate; He was delivered up because of envy. Pilate asked, "What shall I do with Jesus?" Let us see from the Bible what was done by many.

I. JUDAS: SELLING HIM.

Matt. 26:14-16. Disciples were to be afflicted and killed for the name of Christ. Matt. 24:8-9.

II. JEWS: CRUCIFY HIM.

Matt. 27:11-31. Jesus, before Pilate, heard things witnessed against Him. Only one was to be released. Pilate's wife warned him. Barabbas was set free. What will I do with Jesus? Those of that day beat Him, crowned Him with thorns, and led Him away to be crucified. How many crucify Him today? Heb. 6:4-6.

III. DISCIPLES: FORSAKE, DENY.

When the enemies came to take Jesus, the disciples fled. Peter denied three times. Mark 14:54-72; 2 Pet. 2:1; 2 Tim. 2:12.

IV. DISCIPLES: WALK NO MORE.

Matt. 26:56; John 6:54-68; Acts 4:11-12.

V. SAUL: PERSECUTION.

Acts 9:3-5; Gal. 1:13

VI. FELIX: POSTPONE.

Acts 24:24-25. Waited for a more convenient season. 1 Pet. 1:24; Heb. 3:12-15.

VII. AGRIPPA: ALMOST PERSUADED.

Acts 26:28. Good intentions are not enough.

VIII. PILATE: NEUTRAL.

Tried to avoid responsibility. Matt. 27:24. Washed hands. Gave in to Jews to kill Christ.

IX. PENTECOSTIANS: ACCEPT.

Acts 2:22-47; John 14:15.

X. PRODIGAL: RETURN.

Luke 15:11-32; 2 Cor. 5:2. Return to be prepared to meet God.

XI. PETER.

"Thou art the Christ." Matt. 16:16.

XII. THOMAS.

“My Lord and my God.” John 20:28.
